As for the exchange students faculty or graduate school desired by the student, it may not be possible to comply with the desire.</p> <p>In addition, the faculty or graduate school which students enter must be consistent with the students' specialty in their own universities. The Faculty of Global and Science Studies is an exception and does not request a specific specialty.</p>	
Application Procedure	Undergraduate students and Graduate students can be officially admitted only after being reviewed and approved by the department or laboratory of their chosen fields.

It also has Graduate Schools of Humanities, Education, Economics, Science and Engineering, Medicine, Agriculture, East Asian Studies, Innovation and Management of Technology and the Joint Faculty of Veterinary Medicine.

Accommodation

Types and fees	Dormitory rooms are available for international students on both Yoshida Campus and Tokiwa Campus. As a rule, exchange students have to live in the dormitory. We regret that you cannot choose your room. Also, room change is not allowed. Smoking is not permitted in the dormitory and on the site. Visa Procedures

Visa procedures in your country	We will send a Certificate of Eligibility and a letter of Admission from the president of YU to the exchange student. The exchange student should bring these to his or her country's Japanese Embassy or Consulate.
Some documents are additionally required for applying for a VISA. You can refer to Appendix 1 for detailed information.	Attention: Yamaguchi University requires all exchange students or their supporter to submit a certificate of bank statement or an equivalent document that can satisfy the monthly living expense of approximately JPY70,000. This means that the bank balance should be more than JPY840,000 for the 1 year exchange program.

Health	
National Health Insurance required?	Yes. All international students on college student visas must register for the National Health Insurance program regardless of their intended period of stay. They will need to pay the insurance premiums for this insurance. However, when they receive any medical treatment, they will be required to pay only 30% of the total medical fee. The cost of the health insurance varies depending on income and place of residence. For singles with no income, it is approximately JPY20, 000 for one year.
Yamaguchi University insurance required?	All students, including research students and auditors, must take out “Personal Accident Insurance for Students Pursuing Education and Research” (JPY1,000 per year) and “Personal Liability Insurance for Students in addition to the Disaster and Accident Insurance for Students” (JPY340 per year)
